SKI CROSS SX OPEN Format:

⇒ All competitors will be seeded randomly into Ski Cross heats within their category.

⇒ There will be NO timed qualifying runs.

⇒ After the first round of heats, the top finisher(s) in each heat will advance to the next round. The others will move to the

⇒ Last Chance Qualifier (LCQ) round to race again in heats of 3 skiers or less.

⇒ After the LCQ round, the remaining heats will be in a single elimination format where the top 2 skiers advance to the next

⇒ round and the others are eliminated. There will be heats of 4 skiers or less per race.

⇒ Each competitor will have at least 2 Ski Cross runs racing head to head.

Bibs:

Numbered bibs will be distributed at registration with a \$20 refundable deposit immediately following the completion of the competition.

Airlines

Kelowna International Airport is serviced by many of the top Canadian airlines — Air Canada, Jazz, WestJet and Horizon Air. These airlines are partnered with many international carriers and fly non-stop to Kelowna daily from Toronto, Ottawa, Vancouver, Victoria, Calgary, Edmonton, Winnipeg, Saskatoon, Regina, Seattle, Las Vegas as well as Puerto Vallarta, Los Cabos and Cancun Mexico. Airport hosts can be found in the arrivals lounge and are identifiable by their green vests. Daily frequent and efficient shuttle service is available between the resort and the airport by Big White's Official shuttle service. Big White and Silver Star are now the closest Western Canadian resorts to Toronto. WestJet offers 7 non-stop flights per week, as well as daily direct flights from Calgary, Edmonton and Vancouver! Air Canada & Jazz flights in and out of Kelowna have converted to jet service which will eliminate any bag problems and cut flight times from Calgary and Vancouver down to 40 minutes! The competitions will take place in TELUS park. All racers will use the TELUS park chair for training and competition. TELUS Park is accessible by the Bullet chair which is accessible from the main village and will open at 8 :45 AM
